

No experience is necessary. Instructions on trail building, and the safe and proper use of tools/equipment will be given.

Beware of poison oak, ticks and rattlesnakes. Check with a ranger or trail crew leader if you need assistance with identification.

Follow the directions of the park rangers and trail crew leaders at all times. They are trained for trail projects. If you or someone in your work group needs medical attention, contact a ranger or your trail crew leader.
